Can introduce him/herself and others and can ask and answer questions about personal details such as where he/she lives, people he/she knows and things he/she has, Can interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.

A2 - Way stage Level 1	MSA 2 – Early Elementary Modern Standard Arabic	Can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance, very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment). Can describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need.

Can produce simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest. Can describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes & ambitions and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.
